**Description:** This supervisory position provides clinical and educational oversight for an intensive instruction classroom in a public school. Although public schools call the position "lead teacher" this position has limited direct service hours and includes a combination of Ed Coordinator and Specialist responsibilities.

##### General job responsibilities:

- On site supervisor for up to 8 children and staff in Partner Program Classroom
- Supervision and training of tutors/case managers in the classroom
- Clinical/educational case oversight
- Work cooperatively with school personnel (principal, general Ed. and special Ed. staff)
- Work closely and supportively with families

Bennington VT will have 4 Partner Classrooms for the 16-17 school year, 3 of them in the same elementary school and 1 in a middle school.
